Try an example today as well as superb Bordeaux style reds in which Chile, and notably Tarapacá excels.

Andalucía alone has the largest production of olive oil in the world especially using the famous Picual olives. The ham and chorizos are produced in Jabugo, a tinv. remote village world famous for its climatic conditions which make it perfect for curing ham from the local Ibérico black pigs which are free range and fed on acorns.


