Rhône 2015 Report

Clearly, the 2015 growing season treated the Rhône valley's vignerons very kindly. The North fared particularly well, as evidenced by Marcel Guigal, veteran of over 50 vintages, calling it the best he has ever seen. I suppose this means that the South was overshadowed, but with Marc Perrin of Château de Beaucastel calling it "a textbook vintage... the best since '78", we're not exactly looking at a poor performance here either!

Hot summer days came with cooler nights, this diurnal temperature variation helping to retain freshness and vitality in the grapes. Then the rains came just in time to avoid a drought and finally a long, warm autumn allowed growers to pick when they liked, without disease pressures. Phenological ripeness was achieved easily and many smart estates took advantage of this in order to pick early and retain plenty of freshness in the wines, without the danger that the harvested fruit would not yet be fully mature.

The Rhône remains an absolute treasure trove of bargains and one that continues to produce wines that are aimed squarely at the drinker, rather than the investor. In a vintage as strong as 2015, the quality, variety and affordability of these wines, combined with the extra financial incentive for buying en primeur, plus the fact you don't have to wait long to receive them, makes stocking up at this juncture to form the backbone of your cellar a very smart move indeed, and one I fully intend to make.

Needless to say we have been hunting for new producers over in the Rhône itself, as well as putting the wines through their paces in the rather more mundane environment of our UK tasting room and the result of our selection process is a line up of wines that ranges from the very cheap to some of France's finest and one which we are very proud to offer, full of wines we would heartily recommend. In particular I would like to draw your attention to these producers, who are either new to our range and/or who performed exceptionally well in 2015:

Domaine Quart du Roi – a very, very good value red and white duo that will become my new house wines.

Domaine Montirius – beautifully expressive deep reds that eschew the use of new oak, instead allowing the quality of the fruit to speak for itself.

Domaine Roger Sabon – a brilliant Châteauneuf estate that is new to our range. Highly rated both by Parker; "This has long been one of my favorite estates in the southern Rhone" and his successor Jeb Dunnuck; "Domaine Roger Sabon, led by Didier Negron, can seemingly do no wrong and continues to release some of the top wines in just about every vintage."

Domaine Saint-Préfert – another outstanding Châteauneuf property brought into our range for the first time. Jeb Dunnuck warns: "Hold onto your hats with these latest releases from proprietress Isabel Ferrando, as they're easily some of the most badass 2015s I was able to taste. If fact, they resemble a hypothetical mix of the 2007 and 2010."

Red – Châteauneuf-du-Pape 'Classique' £240 per 12 IB

Ferraton Père et Fils – very much under Michel Chapoutier's wing and it shows in the sheer quality of the wines. All six wines are seriously good quality for the money, something which is backed up by some hefty scores from The Wine Advocate's Jeb Dunnuck.

'The entry level 2015 Châteauneuf du Pape Les Olivets comes from the young vines of the estate. Made from 80% Grenache and 10% each of Syrah and Cinsault, aged in foudre, concrete tanks and tronconique tanks, its deep ruby/purple color is followed by a medium to full-bodied, textured red that has lots of red black fruits, roasted garrigue and hints of meatiness, sweet tannin and outstanding length. Ferraton Père et Fils 'Pichères' 2015 Crozes-Hermitage

'Another head turner is the 2015 Crozes Hermitage Lieu Dit Les Pichères, which is from sedimentary soils, was completely destemmed, and aged in a mix of barrels and concrete. It's a huge, full-bodied, rich, unctuous beauty that sports a saturated purple color, tons of plum and blackberry fruit, sweet tannin and a stacked mid-palate. It will keep for a decade. At the moment, all of the Crozes Hermitage releases share a lot of similarities, but I'm sure they'll show more singular characters with additional time in barrel.'

'Made from syrah with a small component vinified in oak (only 15%), this has plenty of bright, pure red fruits on the nose with a handy twist of spices. The palate's slick, really smooth and elegant, the tannins have a gently powdery texture, the flavors are in the red-plum and darker-cherry spectrum, and there's a twist of licorice to close. In contrast to Ferraton's 'Pichères' this has that typical Crozes peppery character, as well as being lighter in weight than many of the reds in this offer. Once again, this is absolutely textbook stuff.

Domaine Vincent Paris 'Granit 30' 2015 Cornas

'Starting with his younger vine cuvée, the 2015 Cornas Granit 30 (1,500 cases) comes from the Patou and Saint Pierre lieux-dits and will see roughly 15 months in barrel. It's a deep, se*y, fruit-loaded beauty that has a saturated purple color, awesome notes of blackberries, blueberries, violets, spring flowers and licorice, as well as full-bodied richness and sweet, yet present tannin. This puppy has tons of fruit and is relatively upfront and textured, but it has enough tannin to benefit from 2-4 years of bottle age.' 91-94 points – Jeb Dunnuck, RobertParker.com, December 2016

'Notes of powdered rocks, graphite, caramelized meats and both cassis and black raspberry emerge from the 2015 Hermitage Les Miaux. This rich, low-acid, chewy, downright decadent Hermitage is another huge success from this estate. 'The team at Ferraton makes two Côte Rôties, both of which are brilliant examples of the quality now coming from this estate. Slightly more expensive than the l'Eglantine, the 2015 Côte Rôtie Lieu Dit Montmain (100% Syrah aged in 15% new French oak) is also full-bodied and impressively concentrated, with notes of acacia flowers, toasted spices, black raspberries and brioche. • When the wine arrives with us in the UK, we will send you the final invoice. This invoice will include the delivery cost to a UK address, duty (currently £2.08 per 0.75l bottle excl VAT), plus the VAT applicable on the day of the final invoice (currently 20%). Upon payment of the appropriate amount we will action your despatch instructions.
